Parish Letter

'O little town of Bethlehem how still we see thee lie!
Above thy deep and dreamless sleep The silent stars go by.
Yet in thy dark streets shineth
The everlasting light:
The hopes and fears of all the years
Are met in thee tonight.'

(Philip Brookes.)

Over the last few months this deadly virus has robbed us of many of the things we cherish, not least the luxury to praise and worship in the way that we love, and which is familiar to us. As Christmas approaches, the question as to how and in what way we shall be able to celebrate it, is like many other questions at this time, rather difficult if not impossible to answer. But one thing Covid-19 can't do, is to take from us the true meaning of Christmas.

God breaking into our lives in the wondrous birth of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the joy and peace, and new life which the presence of Christ in our lives offers to us.

In the last few days it has been announced that a vaccine to protect us from Covid-19 could soon become available. It's for us to accept or not, depending on how we feel. This is seen as a life changer, and indeed it could well be, giving us the chance to lead richer and fuller lives. But the birth of Christ changes us in a deeper and more beautiful way then any vaccine would ever be able to do, and again there is an invitation to us all, to accept or not what God in Christ is offering to us.

The words quoted at the beginning of this article are taken from the Carol 'O little town of Bethlehem' and were written by Philip Brookes, an American vicar in 1868. The picture that he paints of Bethlehem is one of stillness and peace, but I've a feeling that then, as now, Bethlehem was probably neither, but the joy of the visitors to the Holy Family was unmistakable, and I pray that you too may enter that same joy this Christmas time.

I am writing this towards the end of November. Today in the church calendar we celebrate Christ as King, which marks the ending of the church year. Next week we start a new year with the season of Advent, giving us a chance to prepare ourselves for all that Christmas means, which involves not only the birth of Christ, but also the promise of his return.

Christmas is about light and joy, about loving and giving, of being aware of the needs of others; and it's about worship and praise. Maybe we won't be able to celebrate in the way that we would want, but bells will still be rung, glad tidings will still be exchanged, and the hopes and fears of all the years will still be met in Christ.

I would think church services (with Covid-19 restrictions) will very likely resume early in December, and if they do, I'm sure a warm welcome awaits you.

However you spend Christmas, may it be good, and may you be truly blessed.


