FORTHCOMING BUILDING PROJECTS

During 2025, the PCC has planned for us to undertake several Church Building Projects.

Firstly, we would like to upgrade our current heating system - we have agreed a new system and quotation; and are currently awaiting Faculty permission from the Diocese. The installation of the new heating will cost approximately $\pounds10,000$ and we are hoping that it will take place some time in the Spring.

Secondly, we are in discussions with the Architect regarding the repairs and maintenance outlined in the Quinquennial Inspection. It is estimated that to address all these will cost in the region of $\pounds40,000 - \pounds50,000$ much of this cost is for all the scaffolding that will be needed for the roof. We are hoping that much of this work will be able to take place in the Summer.

Thirdly, we would at some point like to upgrade our audio-visual system so that our sound is better (and the hearing loop works) and the projector and screen are improved. We have obtained quotations and the cost is between $\pounds10,000 - \pounds25,000$. At the moment, we do not have funds available for this expense but it is something we would like to seriously consider at some point in the year...
