NEW AUDIO-VISUAL SYSTEM FOR CHURCH

As we are aware, most of our worship at St. John's is now heavily dependent on technology. All this has enabled us to be much more modern and creative in our services; and we would love this to continue and develop. However, much of the equipment that we are using is becoming rather limited and out of date; and as a result, the Church Council would like to upgrade our existing technology and to purchase and install a new LED display screen and a new sound system - including a new hearing loop and lectern, radio and hand-held microphones. The cost for all this will be in the region of £11,000. At the moment we do not have sufficient funds to afford this as most of our savings are ring-fenced to pay for the all the repairs and maintenance highlighted by the recent Quinquennial Inspection. Moreover, we will have to obtain Faculty Permission before anything can be installed. In the meantime we are looking to raise funds and are appealing for donations towards a new system . We have already received a donation of just over £1,000 for which we are very grateful; but if anyone else is able to make a contribution that would be fantastic - no amount is too small - whatever people can give will be really appreciated.
